STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Wilton Academy.

Resolved, That there be appropriated for the use of the 2 trustees of Wilton Academy the sum of twenty-five hun-3 dred dollars for the purpose of completing the repairing 4 and remodeling of the present school building, and for com-5 pleting the installation of a heating plant.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Legislature of 1909 appropriated \$7,500 for repairs and remodeling of the academy building at Wilton, Maine. A building committee was elected from the trustees and they attended to their duties, but upon investigation they found that the cost for the needed repairs was greater than any estimate that had been made by competent architects and builders. The money was wisely and judiciously expended, but in order to make the building safe and suitable it became necessary to over-run the appropriation and already over \$9,000 has been expended. To meet the deficiency and complete the building will require at least \$5,000.
