## STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Madawaska Training School.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of seven hundred dollars for the year nineteen hun-3 dred and eleven and the sum of seven hundred dollars for 4 the year nineteen hundred and twelve for the Madawaska 5 Training School at Fort Kent, the same to be expended by 6 and under the direction of the trustees of the normal schools 7 of the state for providing sewers, a safe method of lighting 8 and other permanent improvements.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Madawaska Training School comprises three buildings, all of wooden construction. The present method of lighting these buildings is entirely by oil lamps. The dormitory connected with the school is a three-storied structure and the method of lighting at present in use is regarded as dangerous to the occupants.
