STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter and rights of the Penobscot Bay Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. That the charter, rights, privileges and fran-2 chises of the Penobscot Bay Railroad Company, a corpora-3 tion organized under Chapter 51 of the Revised Statutes,
4 and the time for performing by said corporation the various
5 acts provided for in said chapter, shall not lapse on account
6 of anything in said chapter contained, and the same is hereby
7 extended for a period of two years from the time when this
8 act shall take effect.
