STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of one hundred eight thousand eight hundred fifty dol-
3 lars (\$108,850) for the year nineteen hundred and twelve,
4 for the use of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital.

For full support of all state charges for the year 1912.

Said sum to be expended under the direction of the Trus-
7 tees of Insane Hospitals.
