STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Western State Normal School.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred
3 and eleven and the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars
4 for the year nineteen hundred and twelve for the Western
5 State Normal School at Gorham, the same to be expended
6 by and under the direction of the trustees of the normal
7 schools of the State for permanent improvements and addi-
8 tional equipment for said school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The appropriations called for in the accompanying resolve are for the purpose of providing permanent improvements in the normal school building at Gorham, of securing additional equipment and providing permanent improvements at the West Gorham school.
