STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 50 of Chapter 18 of the Revised Statutes relating to the public health and the prevention of contagious diseases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 50 of Chapter 18 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word "seventeen" in the first line and inserting in place thereof the word 'twenty-six,' so that said Section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Whoever wilfully violates any provision of the twenty-six preceding Sections, or of said regulations and by-laws, or neglects or refuses to obey any order or direction of any local board of health or health officer authorized by said provisions, the penalty for which is not herein spe-

11 cifically provided, or wilfully interferes with any person or
12 thing, to prevent the execution of the provisions of said
13 Sections or of said regulations and by-laws, shall be pun-
14 ished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars; judges of
15 municipal and police courts and trial justices, shall have
16 jurisdiction original and concurrent with the Supreme Ju-
17 dicial and Superior Courts, of all offenses under said Sec-
18 tions.'
