STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 28 of the Revised Statutes as amended by Chapter 194 of the Public Laws of 1909 in relation to doors swinging outward; fire escapes or egresses from factories, workshops, tenement houses, halls and tenements; inspection, etc.; by adding the following Section.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

'Sect. 46. Should it come to the notice of the State factory inspector or his deputy, or should complaint be made to such State factory inspector or his deputy by any citizen of the State, of the failure of any of the above named officers to comply with any of the provisions of this act, the State factory inspector or his deputy shall at once proceed to investigate such complaint, and if sufficient evidence can

8 be obtained, he shall at once file a complaint against such
9 officer with the county attorney, who shall prosecute the
10 same under the provisions of this act.'
