RESOLVE, in favor of Edward Fahey of Lewiston.

Resolved: That there be paid to the said Edward Fahey
2 of Lewiston the sum of six dollars (\$6.00) per month pay-
3 able quarterly from the fund appropriated for Military Pen-
4 sions, and to begin April 1st, 1911.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Edward Fahey was shot in leg, while in the discharge of his duty while practicing Feb. 13, 1906.

His leg keeps him from performing his labors, and is almost constantly under medical treatment for same.

With this statement of facts, is the report of Dr. W. L. Haskell of the State Board of Health, who has examined the said Edward Fahey.
