STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the taking of smelts in Great brook and in Cold brook, in the town of Stoneham and in the town of Lovell, in the county of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 1. It shall be lawful to take smelts at any time in
2 Great brook, so-called, and in Cold brook, so-called, in the
3 town of Stoneham and in the town of Lovell, in the county
4 of Oxford.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.
