RESOLVE, in favor of the Dexter Loan and Building Association.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of forty-five dollars (\$45.00) to reimburse the Dexter
3 Loan and Building Association for taxes illegally assessed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

There was assessed upon the Dexter Loan and Building Association December 8, 1909, a tax of \$90.00 under the provisions of section fifty-seven of chapter eight, R. S., as amended by chapter 24, Public Laws of 1909. One-half of this amount, or \$45.00, was paid under protest and later Attorney General Philbrook rendered an opinion that no portion of the tax could be sustained and the balance of \$45.00 was abated by the State Assessors on Dec. 16, 1910.
