STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to provide for the admission of evidence in actions for libel in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. At the trial of any action for libel, the defendant

- 2 shall be at liberty to give in evidence in mitigation of dam-
- 3 ages that the plaintiff has already recovered or has brought
- 4 action for damages for, or has received or has agreed to re-
- 5 ceive compensation for, substantially the same libel as that
- 6 for which said action was brought.
