STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to revive and extend the charter and organization of the South Paris Light, Heat and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. Upon the payment to the Treasurer of the State

- 2 of Maine of the amount of its franchise taxes and charges
- 3 now in arrears, the rights, powers and privileges under and
- 4 pertaining to the charter and organization of the South Paris
- 5 Light, Heat and Power Company shall be revived and ex-
- 6 tended for two years from the first day of August, nineteen
- 7 hundred and eleven.
 - Sect. 2. The original purposes of said South Paris Light,
- 2 Heat and Power Company, as recorded in the office of the
- 3 Secretary of State, are hereby amended by adding the fol-
- 4 lowing:

'And to engage in any and all kinds of manufacturing, and 6 to buy, hold, lease, sell and manage real estate for any of its 7 corporate purposes, and to make, generate, sell, and distrib-8 ute electricity for any purpose to any person or persons. 9 firm, corporation, or municipality in the towns of Summer, 10 Greenwood, Woodstock and any portion of the town of Paris 11 outside of the present limits of the South Paris Village Cor-12 poration.
