IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section sixteen of chapter eighty-six of the  
Revised Statutes, relating to sale of shares of the capital stock  
of a corporation on execution.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section sixteen of chapter eighty-six of the  
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the  
3 word "dwells" in the fourth line of said section the words  
4 'otherwise by forwarding it to him by mail, if his residence  
5 is known to such office, postage paid, whether within or  
6 without the state'; and by striking out all of said section  
7 after the word "paper" in the tenth line, so that said section  
8 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 16. In selling said shares or interest, the officer

10 holding the execution shall give notice in writing of the  
11 time and place of sale to the debtor, by leaving it at his last and  
12 usual place of abode, if within the county where the officer  
13 dwells, otherwise by forwarding it to him by mail, if his resi-  
14 dence is known to such officer, postage paid, whether with-  
15 in or without the state; and public notice thereof by posting  
16 it in one or more public places in the town where the sale  
17 is to be made, and in two adjoining towns, if there are so  
18 many, thirty days at least before the day of sale; and shall  
19 publish an advertisement of the same import, naming the  
20 judgment debtor, for three weeks successively before the day  
21 of sale, in some public newspaper printed in the county, if  
22 any, if not, in the state paper.'
