STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 21 of Chapter 17 of the Revised
Statutes of 1903, relating to the registration of dentists.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 21 of Chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes of 1903 is hereby amended by adding after the word "State" in the seventh line of said section, the following: 'Provided that any person engaged in the practice of dentistry previous to 1905, who has passed or shall pass a satisfactory examination in operative and practical dentistry before the board of dental examiners, shall, the above examination having been taken, receive a certificate certified and signed as herein provided,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 21. Any person desiring to practice dentistry or
12 dental surgery in the state, upon first passing a satisfactory
13 examination before said board, in anatomy, physiology,
14 pathology, therapeutics, chemistry and the theory and prac-
15 tice of dentistry, and on payment of fee provided in the fol-
16 lowing section, shall be entitled to registration and shall re-
17 ceive a certificate in due form, signed by the president and
18 attested by the secretary authorizing such person to practice
19 dentistry. Provided that any person engaged in the practice
20 of dentistry previous to 1905, who has passed or shall within
21 three months from the date when this amendment takes ef-
22 fect, pass a satisfactory examination in operative and prac-
23 tical dentistry before the board of dental examiners, the
24 above mentioned examination having been taken on payment
25 of fee as provided in the following section shall receive a
26 certificate certified and signed as herein provided.'
