STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of John Bradbury.

Resolved, That there be paid to John Bradbury of Fairfield
2 a pension of four dollars per month beginning with the first
3 day of January, 1911, and continuing during the pleasure of
4 the Legislature and until otherwise ordered.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

John Bradbury, who served in the Aroostook war, and who is 96 years old with no means of support. He has received four dollars per month for a few years and asks for this amount to help him in his old age.
