STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 50 of Chapter 51 of the Revised
Statutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 50 of Chapter 51 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "board", in the first line thereof the following: 'or one member thereof', so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 50. A majority of the board, or one member thereof, annually, between the first of April and October, and at any other time on application or whenever they think necessary, shall carefully examine the tracks, rolling-stock, bridges, viaducts and culverts of all railroads; and shall annually on December make a report to the governor of their official doings, therein stating the condition of the road and rolling

13 which he may require; and all persons managing railroads
14 shall give the board such information as they at any time
