STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, authorizing the Governor to appoint a commission to investigate investments for savings banks.

Resolved, That the Governor be and he hereby is authorized 2 to appoint a commission of three, to serve without pay, to 3 consider a revision of the law governing investments for 4 savings banks, and institutions for savings. Said commission to report to the next legislature by bill or otherwise.
