AMENDMENT A TO HOUSE RESOLVE NO. 31.

Amend by adding the words 'This resolution shall not be construed to apply to the city of Augusta, which is hereby declared to be forever the seat of government of this state when it reaches the population of forty thousand,' after the word "made" in line 38.
