RESOLVE in favor of the Official Reporter of the House.

Resolved, That there be appropriated and paid to J. S.
2 Estes, the official reporter of the House, the sum of three
3 hundred dollars, for typewriting services employed by him
4 in the preparation of the legislative record.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The House on January 4th, 1911, passed the following order, introduced by Mr. Trafton of Fort Fairfield:

Ordered, That the official stenographer of the House be authorized to procure typewriting services during the present session for the preparation and completion of the legislative record.

This resolve is drawn to pay for typewriting services in pursuance of the order, and is the same amount appropriated for the same purpose at the last session.
