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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

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AN ACT to regulate electric power companies and all persons  
or corporations dealing in electric power or electricity in the  
State.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Electric power companies and all persons or  
2 corporations having electric power or electricity for sale,  
3 and owning or having in control plants for the purpose of  
4 developing electric power or electricity in different munici-  
5 palities in the State must maintain uniform rates of service  
6 in all municipalities where such plants are located, whether  
7 such power is used for manufacturing, mechanical, municipal  
8 or domestic purposes.

Sect. 2. Whenever more electricity or electrical power  
2 is wanted for any of the purposes named in Section 1 of

3 this Act within a municipality where an electric power plant  
4 is located, the same must be furnished until the full amount  
5 of power developed in said plant is used. Provided, how-  
6 ever, that when a demand for more than two hundred horse  
7 power is made upon any one plant in addition to the amount  
8 of power now being used in said municipality the parties  
9 controlling said plant shall have three months notice before  
10 being obliged to furnish the same.

Sect. 3. Any dispute that may arise in regard to prices  
2 to be paid for electric power or electricity for any of the  
3 above purposes named in Section 1 of this Act shall be re-  
4 ferred to the State Board of Public Utilities for settlement.
