STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of ten thousand dollars, for the year nineteen hundred
3 and twelve, for the use of the Maine Insane Hospital.

For building two-story verandas on the Sanborn and Har-
5 low Wings, complete, including window guards for each
6 wing.

Said sum to be expended under the direction of the Trus-
8 tees of Insane Hospitals.

To increase capacity, and to benefit infirm and tubercular cases. To increase sunlight, daylight and pure air for the benefit of that unfortunate class.
