STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum 2 of sixty-five thousand dollars, for the year nineteen hundred 3 and twelve, for the use of the Maine Insane Hospital.

For the complete renovation of the Third Female Wing, 5 including the three-story veranda and every expense except 6 furnishings.

Said sum to be expended under the direction of the Trus-8 tees of Insane Hospitals.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Third Female Wing, a stone building, erected in 1868, requires fire-proofing for safety, modern heating and ventilation to improve its hygienic condition and increase its capacity without detriment to its occupants.
