STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Bridgton Street Railway Company.

'Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Bridg-2 ton Street Railway Company, a corporation organized under 3 the general laws of the State of Maine, Chapter 53 of the 4 Revised Statutes and Laws relating thereto, for the purpose 5 of operating its roads by electricity, compressed air or ani-6 mal power, are hereby extended for a term of two years 7 from the passage of this Act.

Sect. 2. This Act shall take effect when approved.
