*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of one hundred and five dollars, to be paid to Frank E.  
3 Haines, of Deadwater, Somerset county, Maine, said sum  
4 being due for services as chief fire warden in the year 1908.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the year 1908 Frank E. Haines, of Deadwater, was appointed and employed as one of the chief forest fire wardens and in the performance of his duties created a bill of one hundred and five dollars. On presentation of the bill it was found that the appropriation for that year had been exhausted and no provision has since been made for the payment of said bill.
