STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to provide for the Purchase of Supplies by the State through a system of Competitive Bids.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. On and after July 1, 1900, all materials and

- 2 supplies purchased in wholesale quantities by the state, or
- 3 on the credit of the state for any state department or in-
- 4 stitution, shall be purchased by competitive bids under the
- 5 direction of the Governor and Council, whenever, in the
- 6 judgment of the Governor and Council, it is advisable
- 7 to adopt such a method of purchasing supplies.
