STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT concerning Trespass.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Whoever wilfully trespasses upon land which 2 belongs to the State and is appurtenant to the Maine School 3 for Feeble-Minded or after notice from an officer of said 4 institution to leave said land, remains thereon, shall be pun-5 ished by imprisonment for not more than three months or 6 by a fine of not more than fifty dollars.
