STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend that part of Section 5 of Chapter 80 of the Revised Statutes of Maine, relating to regular sessions of the County Commissioners in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 5 of Chapter 80 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word "Second" in the seventeenth line of said Section, and substituting therefor the word 'First,' so that that portion of said Section, relating to regular sessions of County Commissioners in Oxford County as amended, shall read as follows:

'Oxford—on the first Tuesday of May, the first Tuesday of September, and the last Tuesday of December, at Paris.'
