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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

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AN ACT to ratify, confirm and make valid the proceedings of the special town meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Presque Isle held May 3, 1909, and the bonds issued by said town in aid of the Aroostook Valley Railroad Company.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. All the proceedings of the special town meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Presque Isle held May three (3), nineteen hundred and nine (1909), including the votes passed at said meeting to raise by loan twenty thousand dollars to aid in the construction of the Aroostook Valley Railroad Company and to issue bonds of said town to provide for the payment of such loan are hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid.

Sect. 2. The four per cent. bonds to the amount of  
2 twenty thousand dollars, dated April one (1), nineteen hun-  
3 dred and ten (1910), issued by said town to aid in the con-  
4 struction of the said Aroostook Valley Railroad Company  
5 pursuant to the votes passed at said special town meeting  
6 are hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid.
