STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Stockholm Plantation, with statement
of facts.

Resolved, That the sum of forty dollars be appropriated to
2 Stockholm Plantation in the county of Aroostook, to reim-
3 burse said Stockholm Plantation for the burial of a stranger,
4 found dead in a freight car on the 23rd day of September,
5 1910.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The assessors' claim for reimbursement under Chapter 185, Public Laws of 1909, was not allowed by the Governor and Council, in the absence of a coroner's certificate. Hence it is necessary for a resolve, to carry out the spirit of said Public Laws.
