STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Clark Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Cecil F. Clark, Lucien L. Clark and George L.
2 Emery, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby
3 made a body corporate by the name of the Clark Power
4 Company, with all the powers, rights and privileges, and sub-
5 ject to all the duties and obligations conferred and imposed
6 on corporations organized to sell, distribute and supply elec-
7 tricity for light, heat and power under the general laws of
8 the state, except as otherwise provided herein.

Sect. 2. Said company is authorized and empowered to
2 carry on the business of manufacturing, generating, dis-

3 tributing, selling and supplying electricity, light, heat and
4 power for all legal purposes in the towns of Buxton, Hollis
5 and Dayton.

Sect. 3. For the purposes specified in the first two sections
2 of this act, said corporation is hereby authorized and em-
3 powered to set, build, extend and maintain poles, lines and
4 wires in, upon and over such streets and public ways in the
5 said towns of Buxton, Hollis and Dayton as it may deem
6 most expedient in carrying out the purposes of this act, sub-
7 ject to the approval of, and under such reasonable restric-
8 tions as, the municipal officers of the respective towns
9 through which such poles and lines are established may im-
10 pose as to the kind of poles, the manner in which they shall
11 be set, and the height at which the wires shall be carried
12 thereof.

Sect. 4. The capital stock of said company shall not exceed
2 ten thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred
3 dollars each.

Sect. 5. Said company is hereby authorized to issue bonds
2 for the construction of its works upon such rates, time and
3 in such amounts as it may deem necessary, and to secure the
4 same by appropriate mortgages upon its franchises and prop-
5 erty, present and future.

Sect. 6. Said corporation is further authorized to develop
2 such water power as it may own or acquire at Cook's Brook
3 in said towns of Buxton, Hollis and Dayton, for manufactur-

4 ing purposes, and to engage in manufacturing through the
5 use of such power.

Sect. 7. Said corporation may sell and convey its rights,
2 privileges, franchises and property to any other electric light,
3 heat, power or electric railroad or manufacturing corpora-
4 tion chartered by this state, or may purchase and hold the
5 property, rights, franchises and privileges or capital stock
6 of any such corporation.

Sect. 8. The first meeting of said corporation may be
2 called by any incorporator by mailing a written notice, post-
3 age prepaid, to each of the other incorporators seven days
4 at least before the day of the meeting, and any incorporator
5 may act at such meeting by proxy.

Sect. 9. This act shall take effect when approved.
