STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, In Favor of the Publication of the Documentary History of Maine.

Whereas the Maine Historical Society is publishing a 2 series of volumes containing the earliest documents, charters 3 and other state papers illustrating the history of Maine; and 4 whereas the funds of said society derivable from its annual 5 income are insufficient for this purpose; and whereas other 6 states have at great expense procured and published their 7 documentary history at public expense;

Resolved: That the Maine Historical Society agreeing to 9 supervise the copying, attesting, editing, indexing and pub-10 lishing of volumes 17, 18, 19 and 20 of the Documentary 11 History of Maine in the same manner as prior volumes of 12 said Documentary History, published under resolves ap-13 proved February 26, 1907 and March 18, 1909, the Governor

14 and Council are hereby directed to purchase for the state 15 five hundred copies of each of said volumes at two dollars 16 and fifty cents per volume, said volumes to be distributed or 17 exchanged at the discretion of the state librarian.
