STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, concerning the preservation of the archives of the
State of Maine.

Resolved: That the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars
2 be and hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred
3 and eleven and seven hundred and fifty dollars for the year
4 nineteen hundred and twelve, to be expended by the state
5 historian, classifying, collecting, preserving and indexing
6 books, manuscripts, records, documents and papers, now
7 or hereafter in the possession of the State of Maine, or in
8 purchasing books, manuscripts, records, documents and pa-
9 pers relating to the state or valuable for possession by the
10 state, so that the same may be made accessible to all per-
11 sons desiring to use them and who may be entitled to do so;
12 and the state historian shall report biennially to the Gov-
13 ernor and Council the results of work done under this
14 Resolve.
