STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section ten of Chapter seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to the appointment and fees of Masters in Chancery.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section ten of chapter seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto at the
ned end thereof the following: 'The fees and necessary expenses of masters so appointed, and of masters who shall
act in any cause by agreement of parties, shall be fixed and
allowed by the court upon the coming in of the report and,
the Court in its discretion shall so order, shall be paid by
the county on presentation of the proper certificate of the
clerk of courts for that county.'
