STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the transportation of fish and game beyond the limits of the State of Maine for breeding, scientific and advertising purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. The Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and
2 Game shall have authority to grant permits to transport be3 yond the limits of the state live fish or game taken in the
4 state, for breeding, scientific and advertising purposes.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act 2 are hereby repealed.
