STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section fifteen of Chapter fifty-four of the Revised Statutes, relating to expenses of the inspector of hulls, boilers, and engines, and their appurtenances of steamboats upon inland waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section fifteen of Chapter fifty-four of the
2 Revised Statutes as amended by Chapter 225 of the Private
3 and Special Laws of 1909 is hereby further amended by in-
4 serting after the words "inspector of" in the fourth line the
5 word 'hulls' so that said section shall read as follows: 'And
6 the inspector of hulls, boilers, engines and their appurten-
7 ances shall receive annually, in quarterly payments upon the
8 first days of January, April, July and October, in addition

9 to the salary and expenses now allowed by law, and in lieu
10 of allowance for office rent and clerk hire, the sum of two
11 hundred dollars, each.'
