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RESOLVE, in favor of Frank W. Buckman, Secretary of the  
Commission of Pharmacy.

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*Resolved:* That there be and hereby is appropriated out of  
2 any funds of the state not otherwise appropriated the sum  
3 of eleven hundred and fifty-six dollars and forty-three cents,  
4 to be paid to Frank W. Buckman, secretary of the Commis-  
5 sion of Pharmacy for the benefit of said commission and to  
6 make up the deficiency incurred by said commission during  
7 the year nineteen hundred and ten.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The total expenses of the Commission of Pharmacy from January 1, 1910, to December 31, 1910, including printing and binding amounted to twenty-three hundred and thirty-six dollars and thirty-seven cents. Of this amount eleven hundred and fifty-six dollars and forty-three cents is still due the commission and unpaid. There is no appropriation from which to take this amount of money and it must be provided for by a deficiency appropriation. The amounts due the members of the commission to be paid out of this appropriation are as follows:
