STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the County Commissioners of Franklin County for the repair and permanent improvement of the highway in Letter E Plantation and Sandy River Plantation in Franklin County.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars be and is
2 hereby appropriated for the repair and permanent improve-
3 ment of the highway leading from Madrid line through
4 Letter E Plantation and Sandy River Plantation, to the old
5 original highway from Phillips to Rangeley in Franklin
6 county. Said appropriation to be expended under the direc-
7 tion of the county commissioners of said county of Franklin.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The highway for which this appropriation is asked for is the direct thoroughfare from Phillips to the Rangeley Lakes, over which there is an increasing amount of automobile travel during the summer. This road is narrow, ledgy and filled with sharp curves which makes it extremely dangerous for the use of automobiles.
