RESOLVE, in favor of the Lewiston and Auburn Children's  
Home.

---

*Resolved:* That there be and is hereby appropriated for  
2 the benefit, support, and maintenance of the Lewiston and  
3 Auburn Children's Home, a corporation existing in Lewis-  
4 ton, the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen  
5 hundred and eleven, and the further sum of five hundred  
6 dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

A petition signed by many citizens of the cities of Lewiston and Auburn, and accompanying this resolve, states: "We believe that the institution is doing a good and great work, a needed work; that it is under the management and care of devoted men and women, who are laboring at great sacrifices to care for and save poor children, and that it is deserving of the aid asked for from the State."
