STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, authorizing the Land Agent to sell the State's interest in Lot Number 163 in Township Number 18, Range 6, Aroostook County.

Resolved: That the Land Agent is hereby authorized to 2 sell and convey to the actual settler or his grantee thereon 3 the interest the State of Maine has in Lot Number 163 in 4 Township Number 18, Range 6, W. E. L. S., in Aroostook 5 county according to survey of Packard and Nason, State 6 Surveyors, for such price per acre as he may deem equit-7 able.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Lot No. 163 of Township eighteen, Range six, is included in the lots set off by the commissioners in the year 1889, under the "Resolve in favor of settlers in Madawaska territory."

The records show that said lot Number 163 was not assigned to any settler and that the title to the land still remains in the State.

Said lot is now occupied by Demas Pelletier who asks that he be allowed to purchase the State's interest in said lot.
