STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section twelve of Chapter fifty-five of the Revised Statutes relating to Telephone Companies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 12 of Chapter 55 of the Revised Stat-2 utes is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said sec-3 tion and substituting the following:

'Sect. 12. Every corporation operating a telephone line 5 in the state shall, upon application of any other corporation 6 operating a telephone line, allow to such corporation con7 nection between such lines upon the same rates as charged 8 for the same distances upon the line of the corporation so 9 connecting. Said connection shall be made at any pay sta10 tion now existing in the town where said corporation apply11 ing has its chief office, or if there be no such station, then a

12 pay station may be established and maintained by said cor13 poration applying where said connection shall be made.
14 Every corporation authorized by its charter to grant tele15 phone privileges including the leasing of instruments and
16 other appliances shall grant such privileges upon equal and
17 uniform conditions.'
