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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend Section twelve of Chapter fifty-five of the  
Revised Statutes relating to Telephone Companies.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 12 of Chapter 55 of the Revised Stat-  
2 utes is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said sec-  
3 tion and substituting the following:

'Sect. 12. Every corporation operating a telephone line  
5 in the state shall, upon application of any other corporation  
6 operating a telephone line, allow to such corporation con-  
7 nection between such lines upon the same rates as charged  
8 for the same distances upon the line of the corporation so  
9 connecting. Said connection shall be made at any pay sta-  
10 tion now existing in the town where said corporation apply-  
11 ing has its chief office, or if there be no such station, then a

12 pay station may be established and maintained by said cor-  
13 poration applying where said connection shall be made.  
14 Every corporation authorized by its charter to grant tele-  
15 phone privileges including the leasing of instruments and  
16 other appliances shall grant such privileges upon equal and  
17 uniform conditions.'
