STATE OF MAINE

RÉSOLVE, in favor of St. Mary's General Hospital in
Lewiston.

Resolved: That there be and is hereby appropriated the
2 sum of seven thousand and five hundred dollars, to be paid
3 to the St. Mary's General Hospital of Lewiston for the use
4 of said hospital for the year nineteen hundred and eleven
5 and the sum of seven thousand and five hundred dollars for
6 the use of said hospital for the year of nineteen hundred and
7 twelve, both said sums for maintenance.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

It is on the ground of the charitable service rendered to the sick poor of our community and section of the state, that this appeal is made to the Committee of the 75th Legislature. The institution has received assistance from the state for a number of years past.
