STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Stoneham.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred ninety-nine dollars
2 and seventy-one cents (\$599.71) be and hereby is appropri-
3 ated to reimburse the town of Stoneham in the county of
4 Oxford, for money paid out by said town for the support
5 of one Alfred Cole, while confined at the Insane Hospital
6 at Augusta, said Cole being an alien and a State pauper.
