STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section one of Chapter 231 of the Private and Special Laws of 1909.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Amend section one of chapter 231 of the Pri-2 vate and Special Laws of 1909 by striking out in the tenth 3 line in the said section the words "county of Aroostook," 4 and inserting the words 'state of Maine,' so that said section 5 as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. George W. Irving, E. L. Clevland, Fred 7 Simonson, D. W. Corey, C. A. Powers, G. M. Colbath, 8 H. W. Safford, T. B. Bradford, E. S. Stackpole, E. S. Perry, 9 and R. L. Pitcher, with all other members that may here-10 after be admitted to the company, are hereby made a cor-

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11 poration under the name of the Aroostook Mutual Fire 12 Insurance Company, for the purpose only of carrying on 13 business as a mutual fire insurance company for insurance 14 upon potatoes, local or in transit, and upon potato-houses 15 and other real and personal property in the state of Maine 16 with all the powers, rights and privileges, and subject to all 17 the duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all the 18 general laws of the state relating to such insurance com-19 panies, except as herein provided.'
