STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to render more wholesome the milk supply of cities
and towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All cans or other receptacles used in the trans-
2 portation of milk or cream shall be cleansed and sterilized,
3 before being forwarded to the producer or distributor of
4 milk or cream for use.

Sect. 2. Whoever by himself, clerk, servant or agent ships
2 or transports or causes to be shipped or transported any cans
3 or other receptacles not cleansed and sterilized as provided
4 in section one heerof, shall be punished by a fine of not
5 more than fifty dollars for each offense.
