STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the fees for sealing milk bottles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section twenty-one of chapter one hundred and
2 seventeen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended as fol-
3 lows: In line forty-two of said section, after the words
4 "milk bottles," by striking out the words "three cents each,"
5 and writing in lieu thereof the following: 'in lots of one
6 gross or less, one cent each, in lots from one to two gross,
7 three-fourths of a cent each, in lots of more than two gross
8 and not over four gross, one-half cent each, in lots greater
9 than four gross, one-fourth of a cent each.'
