STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT defining and limiting the expenses of Supreme Judicial
and Superior Court Stenographers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Supreme judicial and superior court stenog-
2 raphers shall be reimbursed for their expenses only when
3 in attendance at court away from home, such reimbursement
4 to be made by the county in which the court is held, a de-
5 tailed statement of such expenses, actually and reasonably
6 incurred, to be approved by the justice presiding at such
7 court.
