IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to change the name of Goose Pond in Cumberland
County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The body of water situated in the towns of
2 Gray, Cumberland and Windham, in Cumberland County,
3 about one mile and a half in length and from one half to
4 three-quarters of a mile in width heretofore called the Goose
5 Pond shall hereafter be named and called Forest Lake.
