Said sum to be expended under the direction of the Trus-  
7 tees of Insane Hospitals.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

### Laws 1907, Chapter 100.

For salaries of officers, pay rolls of employees, groceries and provisions, general house furnishings, dispensary department, services of dentist, water, power for ice plant, heat, light and power, household furnishings, repairs to buildings and grounds, insurance, new boiler and its installation, Eastern Steam Line Return, farm department, stable department, greenhouse, laundry department, crusher department, administration expenses, freight and trucking, library books, interest and discount, printing and binding reports, patients' clothing, uncollectible patients' accounts, criminal insane support, Chase Island Hospital support and asphaltting coal pocket roof . . . . .	\$252,300 00
