STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred fifty-seven of the Public Laws of 1909 relating to the employment of minors in manufacturing or mechanical establishments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 54 of chapter 257 of the Public Laws
2 of 1909 is hereby amended by inserting after the words
3 "school committee" in the fourth line thereof, the words
4 'and such age and schooling certificate when duly issued
5 shall excuse such child from attendance at public school,'
6 so that said section, when amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 54. Age and schooling certificates shall be issued 8 by the superintendent of schools of the city or town in 9 which the child resides, or some person designated or au-

thorized in writing by the school committee, and such age and schooling certificate when duly issued shall excuse such child from attendance at public school; but no person shall is issue such certificate to any minor then in or about to enter this employment or the employment of a firm or corporation of which he is a member, stockholder, officer or employee. The person who issues the certificate in accordance with the provisions of this section is hereby empowers and administer the oath provided for therein, but no fee shall be charged therefor.'
